

ROAD COMMISSIONERS REPORT

8-31-19

In April 2019, we removed and replaced a culvert on Kendall Farm Trail. We also repaired a large sink hole at a second culvert on Kendall Farm Trail.

June 2019, Earl Ross from M&H graded and spread ½” shale on our roads.

June 2019, Kutting Edge spread 90 bags of calcium chloride on our main roads. The bags were split evenly between the Highlands and the Overlook.

Most of our road work was performed in August 2019. We removed and replaced two culverts at the 4 way intersection of Overlook, Morel and the Loop Road. One culvert was scheduled to be replaced due to being clogged with mud. Upon inspection, another culvert, located 10 feet from the original culvert, which further channels the water downhill, was found to be clogged. This was an old corrugated metal culvert which was found to have several holes in it which was leaking and starting to create a small sink hole.

A fourth culvert was installed at the intersection of the Overlook Road South and Rt 4. This location needed a culvert as the road would wash out every spring and it would cost us money to repair the damage. D.O.T. had previously stated that they would pay for the culvert but ultimately reneged.

On August 12th, 2019, Mike Ferguson cut back the grass/weeds on the sides of our roads.

On August 16, 2019, Karen Quimby started to cut down brush along some of our roads for a better line of sight. She is doing this in between her other jobs. This work is currently ongoing.

On August 22nd, 2019, Scott from M&H started grading and spreading shale in the Highlands. This work continued until late afternoon on August 23rd when he relocated, graded and spread shale on the roads in the Overlook.
